**Treasurer's Report**: We are up from this time last year by 1.5%. Overall cash Total in the bank is \$118,964. \$1200 in the operating account, \$115,000 in the money market, and \$2700 in the fair account. The projector was purchased and was used during the meeting with the historical committee. Organization has been renewed through jVA for another year and is in good standing. Money to be invested in the CD will be \$90K into one CD. The remaining balance will stay in the account for seed money to pay for any costs incurred.

Peter said we have the funds to support the project. Peter has received a budget for Tom's Trail from Marie. She has planted native plants and trees and done a remarkable job with clean up.
